	Specifications: Does the machine match your product and required capacity?
	Dimensions: Does the machine, including infeed and outfeed conveyors, fit within your available space?
	First impression: What does the external condition and paintwork tell you about the machine?
	Technical condition: Check wear parts such as belts and bearings.
	Deferred maintenance: Which parts need to be replaced?
	Support: Are service and spare parts readily available?
	Control cabinet: Are wiring and components properly installed and in good condition?
	Control system: Are components such as PLCs still available or repairable?
	Test: Is it possible to see the machine in operation?
	Price: Is the price in line with the condition and expected lifespan?

Tip: Bring this checklist with you during inspections to reduce the risk of unexpected issues.
